PROGRAM STEPS



The school selects a team to attend the workshop. The team consists of a classroom teacher, a leadership representative and 2 parents/carers.



The school invites the parents/carers to attend the workshop, to work together as a team.



The school & parents/carers register for the workshop using the links provided.



The school staff complete the compulsory online learning (2 modules) prior to the workshop day.



The school staff and parents/carers complete a day of learning together at the workshop. The team completes a partnership plan to guide future directions.
